



## PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS 24 HOUR URINE COLLECTION

**Facilities:**  
**NoCo Laboratories**

For the proper diagnosis and treatment of your case, your provider has requested a test that requires urine collection over a 24 hour time period. Since laboratory test results are dependent on the quality of the specimen submitted, it is extremely important that this be an accurate and exact 24 hour specimen, and that it be kept refrigerated during and after collection until the specimen is delivered the laboratory.

Please read these instructions thoroughly before you begin your collection. If you have any questions, please call one of the Banner Health Northern Colorado Outpatient facilities listed on the back of this page.

1. Pick a time to start the specimen collection. At this time empty your bladder as completely as possible and **DISCARD THIS SPECIMEN.** Document this date and time of voiding as the Begin Date and Time on the 24 hour urine container.
2. Collect all subsequent voided urine for the remainder of the day and night, including the urine passed before having a bowel movement.
3. Keep the specimen refrigerated in between collections.
4. At the end of the 24 hour collection time, empty your bladder and **ADD** this to the container.
5. Document this date and time of voiding as the End Date and Time on the 24 hour urine container.
6. Ensure that the patient's last and first name and date of birth are also on the container.
7. Bring the container and any paperwork for this order and your insurance card to the Laboratory as soon as possible after the collection is complete.

**NOTES:**

- The specimen cannot be contaminated with stool because this will greatly affect the results.
- If for any reason a portion of the urine is lost, the results will be invalid. Please start the collection again.
