



Labeling Blood Bank Specimens

- 1. Verify patient identification.
- 2. Place Blood Bank Identification (BBID) sticker horizontally on the tube



NOTE: DO NOT place BBID label upside down, 'TOP' must be aligned point toward the tube top/cap side



- 3. Place Cerner label below BBID label
- 4. Cover edge of the Blood Bank ID sticker



NOTE: If NOT performing PPID, DO NOT forget to manually write the collection date/time and Collectors ID



- 5. Wrap the label around the tube.
- 6. Do not cover the BBID.
- 7. Leave as much of the barcode exposed as possible



NOTE: Make sure label is on straight and not wrinkled



NOTE: Reference the Typenex Directions for Use for instructions on BBID wristband placement
