

# How to Use this Guide to Laboratory Services- Test Directory

**Search for a test by test name:** Type all or part of the test name in the Search box and press "search". All matching tests will display in the list below the search box. Select the desired test from the list and click on the test code or test name to open the test and view the test information.

Note: The search will pull up all tests that have the search word in the test code, test name, or test alias definitions for a test.

**Search by for a test by CPT® code:** Type the CPT® code in the search box and press "Search". All matching tests having that CPT® code will display in the list below the search box. Select the desired test from the list and click on the test code or test name to open the test and view the test information.

**Search by for a test by lab code:** Type the CHOMP or Nichols Diagnostics-Quest Lab Order code in the search box and press "Search". All matching tests having that code will display in the list below the search box. Select the desired test from the list and click on the test code or test name to open the test and view the test information.

Note: The search will pull up all tests that have the search word in the test code, test name, or test alias definitions for a test.
