New Test Name - RPR TITER MONITORING New Test Code - LAB1230621

EXPLANATION: A stand-alone rapid plasma reagin (RPR) titer for syphilis will become available at Ruby Memorial and Berkley Medical Center. This test is intended for:

- 1. monitoring treatment in patients with a known history of syphilis, where documentation of decline in RPR titer is needed, or
- 2. evaluating neonates with suspected congenital syphilis.

The test should NOT be used for primary diagnosis of syphilis. For screening or initial syphilis diagnostic testing, see Syphilis Screening Algorithm with Reflex (**LAB1230000**), which includes RPR when indicated.

METHOD: Flocculation

REFERENCE VALUES: Negative

SPECIMEN REQUIREMENTS: Gold Top Tube. Pediatric: 2 Gold Top Microtainers

SPECIMEN REJECTION CRITERIA: Non-validated sample type, specimen container not labeled properly, broken specimen container, sample greater than 7 days since collection, or frozen samples.

SPECIMEN STABILITY INFORMATION: Refrigerated: 7 days

DAYS TEST SET UP: Monday-Friday
